Daisy Lane Stamp Set Bundle (with medium Daisy punch)

Ink Pads

Cardstock & Cutting Instructions

So Saffron: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" scored at 4 1/4", 4" x 4"

Very Vanilla: scrap

Mosaic Designer Series Paper:

2 pieces 1" x 4" for side panels

2 pieces 2" x 2 7/8"

1 piece 2 7/8" x 4"

Accessories

Silver Faceted Gems

Daisy Punch

Glue Dots

Layering Oval Dies

Dimensionals

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Score the So Saffron cardstock at 4 1/4" and fold in half to make the card base.
2. Line up the front of the card on your cutter and cut the 2 short sides of the front at 1 1/4" up to the center fold.
3. Use adhesive and glue down the two narrow sides. Attach the Designer paper to the top of these sides.
4. Score the center section at 2 1/8" to make the fold for the easel part of the card.
5. Attach the two 2" x 2 7/8" pieces of designer paper to the outside of the fold. NOTE: I used 2 different patterns for this piece. Attach the 2 7/8" x 4" piece of DSP to the center.
6. Stamp 2 of the large daisy and 2 small daisies on the piece of So Saffron cardstock with Crushed Curry ink. Cut out with the two daisy punches. Attach the two large daisies together and attach the two small daisies together and add on top of the large daisies. Attach a Silver Faceted Gem to the middle of the Daisy. Attach to the front of the folded piece. Cut out a bird from the Mosaic patterned DSP and add next to the daisy with a dimensional.
7. Stamp "Smile" with crushed curry ink on a scrap of very vanilla cardstock. Cut out with an oval die. Cut out a scalloped oval from a piece of So Saffron cardstock. Attach the sentiment to the scalloped oval. Attach to the center front of the card using a dimensional. This will hold the easel portion of the card open.
